## Re: Year 12 progression exams season 1

A level Progression Exams (Season 1) run immediately after the Easter holidays from **Monday 15**<sup>th</sup> **to Friday 19**<sup>th</sup> **April 2024**. The aims of these assessments are to:

- Give each student the opportunity to sit full length A level exams in a formal, controlled setting
- Identify student strengths and areas for development at the halfway point in the year
- Inform latest UCAS predicted grades, particularly important for early applicants such as those students aiming for Oxford/Cambridge and Medical/Dental/Veterinary school destinations
- Highlight those students who need additional support at this critical stage in their education

## **Key reminders:**

- Students only come to school for their scheduled examinations, **apart from those students studying BTEC Applied Science** who are still required to attend lessons when they do not clash with their exam
- They must bring the correct equipment and IDs/lanyards and ensure they are adhering to sixth form dress code to be admitted into the exam hall by the invigilators: <a href="https://bealsixthform.co.uk/information/beal-sixth-form-dress-code-2023-24/">https://bealsixthform.co.uk/information/beal-sixth-form-dress-code-2023-24/</a>
- If students wish to study at school, they must sign in with the sixth form reception and base themselves in the sixth form block
- Timetables have already been distributed with venue/timings/seat numbers and students should read these very carefully
- Students must report to the **upper site changing room or SF14/15 as usual by 8.45am or 1.45pm** (9am and 2pm are the start times, not arrival times).
- If a student is **unwell, running late or has another personal reason** why they are unable to sit an exam, please notify us immediately at <a href="mailto:sixthformabsence@bealhighschool.co.uk">sixthformabsence@bealhighschool.co.uk</a> or 02085519378
- Students who arrive late must not enter the exam hall but must instead report to the sixth form reception
- Normal lessons will resume at 8.30am on Monday 22nd April 2024
- Results and latest predictions will be published on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> June 2024
- Progression Exams Season 2 will be in early October 2024 and season 3 in early March 2025.
